

A letter from Dana

Dear Parents,

Happy December! It is a big month for our students at WCSS. Our Winter Arts Festival is just around the corner on <u>December 5th</u> and our students are so excited to show off their talent and art. Doors open at 5:00 and the first set of performances (Pre-K - 3rd Grade) begins at 5:15. Our second set of performances (grades 4-5, Waterside Singers and Dancers) will begin around 6:15PM. We are so excited for this night and we are looking forward to seeing ALL of our WCSS Families on this night!

Recess is a very important social and active time for our students. It is very important that our students wear sneakers every day. Additionally, please note that rough housing is NOT allowed during recess or during the school day. If this does occur, it gets brought to either my attention or Katie, our AP and gets handled immediately. Students who rough house can have consequences such as lunch detention or missing out on their enrichment clusters. We would love you cooperation with encouraging our children to keep their hands and feet to themselves at ALL times, which is part of our schoolwide rules and kindness initiative.



Classwork - 40%
Assessments/Quizzes/Tests - 40%
Class Participation - 15%
Projects - 5%

65% or below = Level 1 (significantly below grade level standards)

66% - 79% = Level 2 (below grade level standards)

80% - 89% = Level 3 (on grade level standards)

90% - 100% = Level 4 (above grade level standards)
